It is also useful to provide a alerts about service due dates also to both beneficiaries and service providers. This initiative also provided a dash.

Nirbhaya app:

This app is one of the most important outcomes of digital India. This app is an android emergency application, based on to send a distress call or emergency message to a specified contact number or group in an emergency situation faced by a woman.

Beti Bachao and Beti Padhao campaign:

Beti Bachao and Beti Padhao campaign started by our government aimed at guaranteeing girls are born, nurtured and educated ,feel secure without discrimination. From 1961, Child Sex Ratio is continuously declining in India due to many reason. According to CSR is 945,927 and 918 during 1991, 2001 and 2011 respectively. This indicates how women disempowerment and the situation is alarming. CSR indicates pre-birth discrimination and post birth discrimination of girl child. Misusing of diagnostic tests is leading to Decreasing Child Sex Ratio in our country. To deal with declining CSR Government of India had announced Beti BachaoBetiPadhao initiative. This is being implemented in hundred selected districts where we find low child sex ratio in the graph. This campaign is jointly carried out by Ministry of women and child develops ment, Ministry of Human Resource development and Ministry of Health and Family welfare of India. The prime objectives of the initiative is -include to prevent gender biased sex selective elimination, to Ensure survival, secure and protection of the girl child and to ensure education and growth of the girl child.

Mahila E-Haat:

This portal is initiated in two languages. It was started in the year 2016. This portal is an online Marketing platform useful for women entrepreneurs, women NGOs and self Help Groups. This wonderful portal is useful for showcasing the products manufactured by women. This portal facilitates a direct contact between buyer and seller. Women entrepreneurs from different states are showcasing more than two thousand products as on date. There is a provision for eighteen categories of products which can display on this platform. They include clothing, bags, home decor, carpets, rugs, foot mats, fashion accessories, 'jewellery, decorative and gift items, baskets, boxes, pottery, grocery, cushion covers, staples, organic, home decoration item, natural products, file folders, soft toys, industrially products, educational aids, and other miscellaneous items. This platform is useful for more than three lakh beneficiaries directly and indirectly.

Women Helpline Scheme:

According to this scheme a toll free number which provide twenty-four hours service to girls or women facing violence and harassment in any sphere including both private and public sector. They can also get information about women schemes and welfare programmes. This scheme also facilitate intervention in crisis and non-crisis situations by directing to police, hospitals, protection officers, ambulance and local district level authorities.

Mahila Digital Saksharta Abhiyan:

This initiative was formulated to instruct and provide training in Informa tion Technology to Fifty two and Half Lakh women including Anganwadi and ASHA workers in different states across the country. Its objective is to making one person in every person digitally literate. It is one of the integral components of Prime Minister's vision of towards digital India journey.

The safety score of a place is based on 9 parameters, like lighting, openness, visibility, people, security, walk path, gender usage, and feeling. The app also tells you about the public transport is availability in that area, whether there is a police station, pharmacy or ATM nearby or not available in the area. This app also facility you to share your real-time location via GPS tracking, with your friends or family.



- Himmat: Himmat app was launched by Delhi Police due to the increasing crime in the city day by day. The major features of this app is that you can send your exact location with
 - audio and video of the surroundings in case of unsafe situation to Delhi police control room. The Delhi Police can take an emergency step and then immediately send the nearest Police help to the victim. The app has a user-friendly interface and also is pretty easy to use, to register you need to enter your mobile number, you will then receive an OTP for verification.
- ❖ Shake2Safety: Shake2safety app is one of the easiest and simplest apps to use. Other way we can say that it is user friendly app. All you need to do is to shake your smartphone or press the power button, and this will instantly send an SOS message to the registered mobile numbers. One of the best



and magical features of this app is that it works without the internet too; the app also allows you to report robbery, accident or any natural disaster also.

- ❖ Eyewatch SOS for Women: Eye watch is one of the a great app for women safety because it captures audio and video of the users surrounding and sends it to the registered contacts number with an alert message. The great thing about this app is that it is highly accurate and it can also function even without GPRS, one another feature of the app is that once you are safe, you can notify a message to the registered numbers that I am safe.
- ❖ Family Locator Gps Tracker: Family Locator app is one of the safety app, which can be used by your entire family once. It is the best safety apps which allows you to connect with all your family members. You can create your private groups called as circles, and view the real-time location of Circle Members on a private family map that's only visible to your Circle. You receive the real-time alerts when your family members arrive or leave a destination. You can also see the location of a lost phones using this app too. The app works in such a way that your entire family stays connected with you once and feels safe.
