E - learning can also be a good substitute for non - availability or scarcity of teachers in new branches of knowledge, e.g. through the medium of EduSat (educational satellite), students from other colleges can view the lectures conducted by lecturers in IIT through video shooting of the lectures.
- 6) Equality in education - Due to e - learning, it will be possible for a person living anywhere in the country to take best education in the world. If the use of e- learning increases, then all will get equal education and it will help in bridging the gap between rural and urban education.
