Ho<sub>3</sub>: There would be no significant difference between the average scores obtained by girls and boys of standard 9th of secondary school in achievement test of social science.

 $Ho_4$ : There would be no significant difference between the average scores obtained by girls and boys of standard 9th of practicing school Gujarat University in achievement test of social science.

 $Ho_s$ : There would be no significant difference between the average scores obtained by girls and boys of standard 9th of practicing school of Gujarat University in achievement test of social science.

Ho<sub>6</sub>: There would be no significant difference between the average scores achieved by students of reserved cast and unreserved cast in achievement test of social science.

 $Ho_7$ : There would be no significant difference between the average scores achieved by students of reserved cast and unreserved cast of primary school in achievement test of social science.

Ho<sub>8</sub>: There would be no significant difference between the average scores achieved by students of reserved cast and unreserved cast of secondary school in achievement test of social science.

Ho<sub>9</sub>: There would be no significant difference between the average scores achieved by students of reserved cast and unreserved cast of practicing school of Gujarat University in achievement test of social science.

 $Ho_{10}$ : There would be no significant difference between the average scores achieved by students of reserved cast and unreserved cast of practicing school of Gujarat Vidyapeeth in achievement test of social science.

Ho<sub>11</sub>: There would be no significant difference between the average scores obtained by students of

primary school, secondary school and practicing schools in achievement test of social science.

279 Primary school governed by Ahmedabad District Panchayat in which 9th standard curriculum was taken, 8 experimental schools affiliated with Gujarat University, 405 general grant in aid secondary schools in the area of Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation and one experimental school of Gujarat Vidyapeeth, thus all these schools have 9th standard in primary section make the population of the present study.

#### 10. LIMITATIONS OF THE STUDY:

#### The present study has following limitations:

- 1. The present study is limited to students of Gujarati Medium secondary schools of Gujarat.
- 2. The present study is limited to students of social science in standard 9th of Gujarati medium secondary schools of Gujarat.
- 3. The present study is limited to students studying in experimental schools of Gujarat Vidyapeeth and Gujarat University.
- 4. The present study is limited to students of primary schools in Panchayat, Municipal Corporation's common secondary schools and experimental schools of undergraduate training colleges.

#### 11. SCOPE & RESEARCH TOOL:

The achievement test of social for students of Std.9 being standardized as partial fulfillment for the Ph.D. degree of Baba Saheb Ambedkar Open University is taken as a tool for the present study. This was a multiple choice test, in which 70 items were included. Each item has 4 devices. 70 items were allotted 75 marks in achievements test. The total content of social science in 8th standard is taken for

the achievement test. There are 4 items of knowledge, 16 items of understanding, 8 items of application and 5 skill based items are there in this achievement test.

#### 12. WORK OUTLINE OF THE RESEARCH:

The main objective of the present study was to test the achievement of the 9th Std. Students in Social Science. Students find the subject of social science comparatively difficult. The subject is also useful for National character building and for preparing ideal citizens.

The tool to test the achievement is a standardized.

"Achievement test of social science for 9th standard student" prepare for the degree of Ph.D. in the year 2009 in Baba Saheb Ambedkar Open University.

The research has taken permission from principals of Kumar Vinay Mandir (Gujarat Vidyapeeth, Ahmedabad) A. G. High School (Navrangpura, Ahmedabad) Gandhi Vidyalaya (Asarva, Ahmedabad) and Shantipura Primary School (Dist.Sanand, Ahmedabad) for the data collection of the present study.

All school were informed on particular day for data collection students were given answer sheets, students were provided necessary stationary to fill up the form. After wards they were given achievement test students were instructed property regarding the achievement test and were given 40 minutes to complete the test.

In the present study variables like sex (male-female) type of school (Primary, secondary experimental under municipal corporation and panchayat, grant-aid in and university affiliated experimental schools) and Cast (Reserved and unreserved) were included and for that scores of achievement test were calculated through M.S. Excel programme. The data collected was analyzed according to objective & hypothesis of the research in which the maximum possible score was 35, while the area of achieved score was between 1.15 to 16. The data was analyzed and 't' value. Standard deviation were calculated to know the significant level of the scores Graphic presentation was done for interpretation.

#### 13.WORK OUTLINE OF THE RESEARCH:

The findings being gathered from the analyses were as follows.

- 1. Majority of the students has less achievement scores while minor students have scored high.
- 2. The female students achievement is more than male students towards social science.
- 3. The female students of primary school have higher achievement than the male student of primary schools.
- 4. Similar female students of secondary schools have higher achievement in social science than male students.
- 5.Male and Female students social science achievement in experimental schools of social science is almost similar.
- 6.Male and Female students of experimental school of Gujarat Vidyapeeths achievement in social science is almost similar.
- 7. Unreserved students achievement is higher than reserved students.
- 8.The achievement social science of revered category in common secondary school have similar achievement in social science.
- 9. The students of both reserved and unreserved category in common secondary school have similar achievement in social science.
- 10. The reserved and unreserved students of experimental school of Gujarat University have similar achievement in social science.

- 11. The reserved and unreserved students of experimental school of Gujarat Vidyapeeth have similar achievement in social science.
- 12. There is significant difference in the average score of achievement test according to types of schools.
- 13. The student of experiment school affiliated to the Gujarat University has the higher achievement in social science while students of common secondary school have the lower achievement in the social science.

#### 14. EDUCATIONAL IMPLICATIONS OF THE RESEARCH:

The implications of the present research were as follows.

- The student of social science in Std.9 have very law achievement in the achievement test of social science.
- 9th Std. female students have higher achievement than male student in achievement test of social science
- The students of unreserved category have higher achievement in the achievement test of social science than the students of reserved category in 9th Std.

The achievement of students of experimental schools of under teacher test of social science than the student of primary schools in District Panchayat.

#### **15.SUGGESTIONS:**

Students should be taught with different and novel techniques for the qualitative development of the social science education. Especially student should be taught content with direct experience. Social science laboratory should be provided in schools for it and experimental also should be done in it, students will not find this subject difficult if they are facilitated with maps, samples models in the lab. Student will have qualitative development. The aim of Education & Social Science can be obtained. For better teaching of social science there should be competition of practical lessons which will definitely inspire teachers to teach science effectively.
