### 1. ABSTRACT :

**T**he present paper discusses the availability of open access books which are available in the Directory of Open Access Books (DOAB) and special reference to sociology. The appropriate data has been collected from the open access directory from <http://www.doabooks.org/> in September 2015. Based on the available data the total 300 sociology books are available as on 14. 09. 2015. In this directory 30 books are single author, 17 books are double authors and 9 books are three and above others are contributed and books are available in more than 4 languages.

### 2. INTRODUCTION:

Information technology reached all zones of human activities. Adoption of ITC in education field, it supports to retrieve of open access information and reduced most of the problem of information seeking for research and development. Open access is playing a vital role now days because of it provides freedom to access of information resource anywhere in the world. The Open access has several methods of access and usage without paying any charges and full permission to copy, download, print, distribute, archive, translate and even change format to its usage with varying restrictions.

### 3. DIRECTORY OF OPEN ACCESSBOOKS (DOAB)

The Directory of Open Access Books (DOAB) is a facility to provide open access on monographs. It provides a searchable index with links to the full- texts of the publications at the publisher's website or repository for peer-reviewed monographs through open access business model. It invites the academic publishers to provide the metadata of their open access books to DOAB. The DOAB is open to all academic publishers to provide the data. The main aims are to fulfill all the subjects as well as all languages which consists of many books as possible.

The DOAB was officially launched on 1 July 2013 at the Open Access Monographs in the Humanities and Social Sciences Conference at the British Library in London<sup>2</sup>. However, unofficially it was operating since 2011 and its beta version was launched in 2012. The DOAB is a service of the Open Access Publishing in European Networks (OAPEN) Foundation. The OAPEN Foundation is an international initiative dedicated to open access monograph publishing, based at the National Library, The DOAB is being developed in close cooperation with Lars Bjørnshauge and Salam Baker Shanawa (Director of Semper Tool), who were also responsible for the development of the

Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ).

### 3.1 AWARDS FOR DOAB

IFLA/Brill Open Access award' DOAB received the 2015 IFLA/Brill Open Access award, which was created to reward initiatives that facilitate and/or promote Open Access scholarly monographs in the humanities or social sciences. The jury recognized DOAB's 'invaluable worth by becoming the central hub of the global infrastructure for open access book publishing.' 'Best Free Reference Web Site' DOAB was selected as one of the MARS Best Free Reference Web Sites for 2013, voted for by member librarians from around the United States. 'MARS: Emerging Technologies in Reference' is a section of the Reference and User Services Association of the American Library Association (ALA). 'Best New Product' DOAB received the Best New Product award in the 2012 series of awards for the best and worst electronic products of interest to libraries, sponsored by the Charleston Advisor. The Charleston Advisor publishes reviews of online resources for libraries. All reviews are peer-reviewed by librarians.

### 4. SUBJECTS COVERED IN DOAB

Overall 300 e-books are available on Sociology through DOAB. It covered 17 major subjects areas and 10 sub-fields of social science. Maximum e-books are available on Social Sciences (370 books), Sociology (300 books), Education (173 books), Psychology (150 books), Media and communication (97 books), Ethnology (81 books), Anthropology (79 books), Gender Studies (52 books), Library and Information Science (21 books) and Sports Science (16 books).

### 5. ABOUT A SOCIOLOGY

Sociology, a social science that studies human societies, their interactions, and the processes that preserve and change them. It does this by examining the dynamics of constituent parts of societies such as institutions, communities, populations, and gender, racial, or age groups. Sociology also studies social status or stratification, social movements, and social change, as well as societal disorder in the form of crime, deviance, and revolution. The term sociology was coined by French philosopher Auguste Comte in 1838, who for this reason is known as the "Father of Sociology." Comte felt that science could be used to study the social world.
