Track and field is categorized under the umbrella sport of athletics, which also includes road running, cross country running, and race walking. Presently in this study preferences is been given to the athletes who made place between one to eighth positions in Track and field events.

PURPOSE OF THE STUDY:

Physical Education is a vigorous physical activity that can provide an inexpensive and practical workout for most people. Physical Education Training is an excellent all-round exercise program since any amount of exercise can be incorporated with the program to enhance the body's physical and physiological fitness. Physical education and sports, being integral parts of education have also experienced the effect of scientific advancement. Now, the sportsmen have been able to give outstanding performance because of involvement of new scientifically sustained training methods and means of execution of sports exercise such as sports techniques and tactics, improvement of sportswear and equipment's as well as other components and conditions of the system of sports training. • To explore the sports achievements of Men and Women Athletes of Mangalore University Athletics players team from All India Athletics Meet Running, Jumping and Throwing Events.

• Through its investigation the present study aims to recommend the Mangalore University authorities and Degree College Affiliated under the Mangalore University to provide proper infrastructure facilities to improve the standard of Indian Athletics players Running, Jumping and Throwing Events at grass root level in Mangalore University region.

HYPOTHESES OF THE STUDY:

• There would be number of Athletics players represented to Athletics team from All India Athletics Meet Running, Jumping and Throwing Events in Mangalore University region.

• There would be differences in the total number of Athletics player's representation to Mangalore University Athletics team from All India Athletics Meet Running, Jumping and Throwing Events.

• Through its investigation recommendations would be made to the Mangalore University authorities and Mangalore University under the Degree College of each district to provide the proper infrastructure facilities to improve the standard of Indian Athletics players Track Event Running, Jumping and Throwing Events at grass root level in the Mangalore University region.

• This study assumes great significance given to its comprehensive study to delineate the contributions and achievements of Mangalore University region All India Athletics Meet Running, Jumping and Throwing Events.

Sources of Data and Information
