Through the questionnaire based survey, newspaper reading habits among undergraduate and postgraduate students of SVC library has been studied. A total no of 500 questionnaires were administrated to the students, and 460 were received where the response rate was 86% these are used for the analysis. It was discovered from the analysis that majority of the respondents read newspaper daily.
