The statistical techniques used are the result shows that the Emotional Intelligence is directly affecting the academic Achievement of PG students of K.S.W.U, Bijapur.



The Home Environment is directly affecting the Academic Achievement of PG students of K.S.W.U, Bijapur. The present study is to provide knowledge and skills are needs to understand the Post Graduate SC and Non-SC students Home Environment and Emotional Intelligence relation. How these variables influence on their Academic Achievement is the focus on SC and Non-SC students studying in K.S.W.U, Bijapur.

The study aims to find out a positive and significant correlation was observed between Academic Achievement and Home Environment scores of Postgraduate students of Karnataka State Women's University, Bijapur. 6. There is no relationship between academic achievement with self concept, personality, emotional intelligence and home environment scores of unmarried postgraduate students of Karnataka State Women's University Bijapur

Variables: Independent variables are Personality and Self concept Dependent variable is Academic Achievement.

Limitations

The present study was confined to schedule and non schedule postgraduate students of Karnataka State Women's University Bijapur.

Methodology

The study was designed to find out Academic Achievements of schedule and non schedule postgraduate students of Karnataka State Women's University Bijapur. MAJOR FINDING

- 3. The non-schedule postgraduate students have significant higher personality scores as compared to schedule postgraduate students of Karnataka State Women's University Bijapur
- 4. A positive and significant correlation was observed between academic achievement and personality scores of married postgraduate students of Karnataka State Women's University Bijapur
- 5. A positive and significant correlation was observed between academic achievement and self concept scores of unmarried postgraduate students of Karnataka State Women's University Bijapur
- 6. A positive and significant correlation was observed between academic achievement and personality scores of unmarried postgraduate students of Karnataka State Women's University Bijapur
