Eighty kabaddi players from different clubs in Solapur City were taken for the study. 40 Male and 40 Female players playing at school and college level were selected. A Questionnaire consisting various question regarding the Socio Economic condition were prepared and used for collecting data, a self made objective type questionnaire was used. The study was delimited to the players from Solapur city only.

Area of Study- Solapur City (Registered Kabaddi Club)





#### FINDINGS-

- 50% of Boys Kabaddi players and 85% of Girls Kabaddi players are having low socio economic condition and financial status
- 37.5% of Boys Kabaddi player and 15% of Girls Kabaddi players are in medium socio economic condition and financial status
- Where as 12.5% Boys Kabaddi players and 0% of Girls kabaddi players are in high socio economic condition

#### **CONCLUSION-**

This case study reveals the assumption that the socio economic status had an influence, via intermediate factors, on the state of health. Cultural factors were closely connected to socio-economic position and also played a role here. Social health differences arose if the factors that influenced health were unequally distributed between different socio economic groups.
