There is lot of social networking sites in India. Library and Information Science Links (LIS Links) is the India's first and largest social network site for library professionals. 2. PUBLIC LIBRARIES IN CHENNAI

Tamilnadu Directorate of Public Libraries-a department functioning under the Ministry of School Education, Government of Tamilnadu,(India) has 4042 libraries under its umbrella. These 4042 libraries are categorized in to various types right from State library through District Central Library with its branches scattered all over the 32 districts in the state. (D .P.L Govt. ofTamilnadu 2012)

In Chennai city total number of Public libraries is 141 including 1 state central library, 1 District central library, 1 Anna centenary library, 5 Circle libraries,7 full time branch libraries and 126 branch libraries .RRRLF promotes public library services rendering book and financial assistance to the public libraries under different schemes of assistance in collaboration with Library Department or Department in charge of Public Library Services. With the help RRLF 15 out of 141 Libraries has internet facility and only 14 libraries allow the users to access the internet facility.

These approaches were mathematically formalized in the 1950s and theories and methods of social networks became pervasive in the social and behavioral sciences by the 1980s. Social network analysis is now one of the major paradigms in contemporary sociology, and is also employed in a number of other social and formal sciences. Together with other complex networks, it forms part of the nascent field of network science.

4. SOCIAL NETWORKING SITE (SNS)

Social networking site is an online service, platform that focuses on facilitating the building of social networks or social relations among people who, for example, share interests, activities, backgrounds, or real-life connections. A social network service consists of a representation of each user (often a profile), his/her social links, and a variety of additional services. Most social network services are web-based and provide means for users to interact over the Internet, such as e-mail and instant messaging. Online community services are sometimes considered as a social network service, though in a broader sense, social network service usually means an individual-centered service whereas online community services are group-centered. The collected data were analyzed and interpreted using statistical tools.

10. ANALYSIS AND INTERPRET OF DATA

All the respondents surveyed indicated that LIS Links (Social Network Site) is very useful in meeting some of their information requirements for the research purpose. All the respondents were found to have knowledge of Internet and Social Network

The total number of public libraries in Chennai 141 out of 15 has internet facility and 13 where allowed to users to access the internet. So data collected from these 13 libraries only. The Researcher directly visited all the libraries and interacts with librarian after that collect data from users by structured questionnaire. Total no of questionnaire distributed is 80 and get back 50 questionnaires.

Figure 1. the Gender wise response to questionnaire

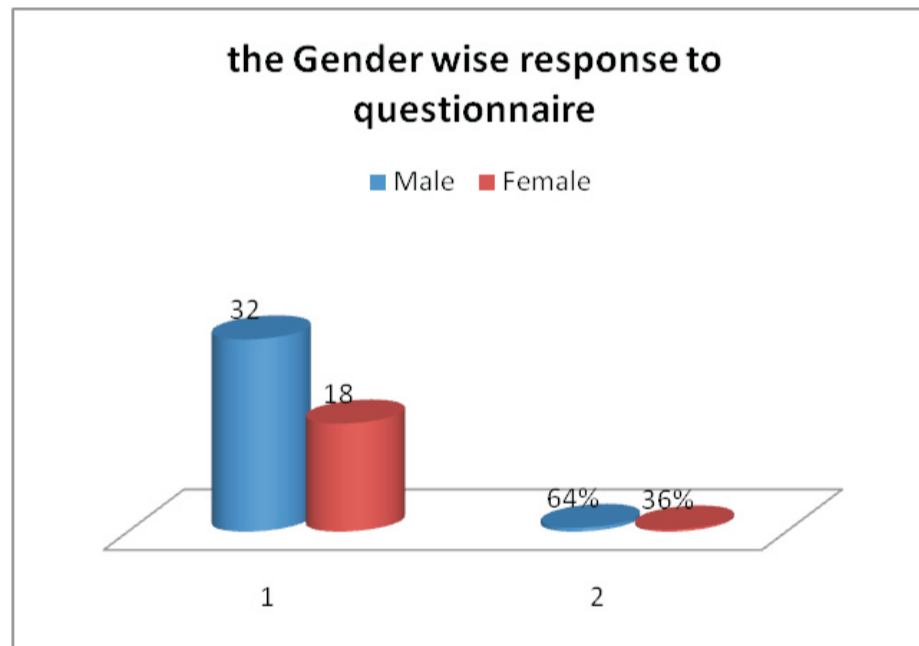


Table 1 and Figure 1 shows that out of 50 respondents 32 (64%) were male and 18 (36%) were female.

Figure 2. Frequency of use LIS Links

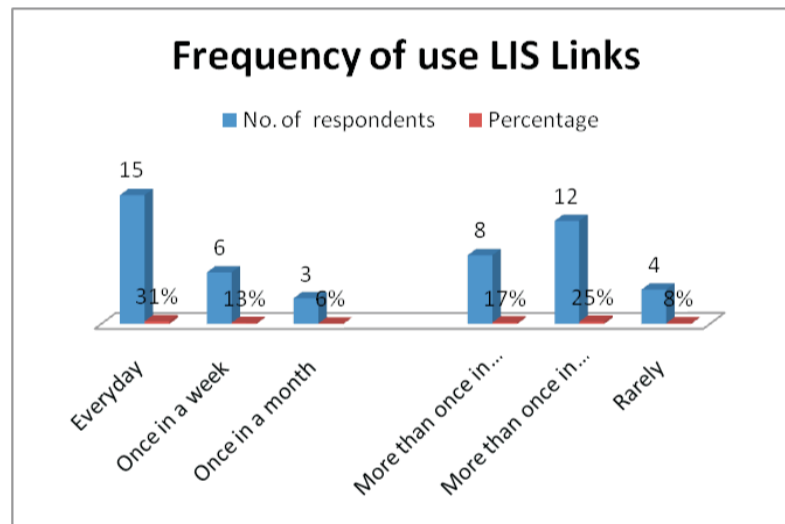

Figure 3. Ways of LIS Links in Creating Career Development Skills

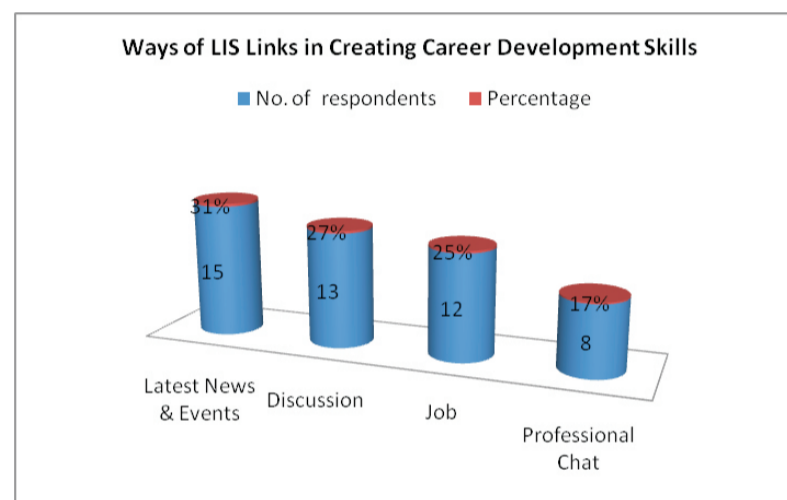
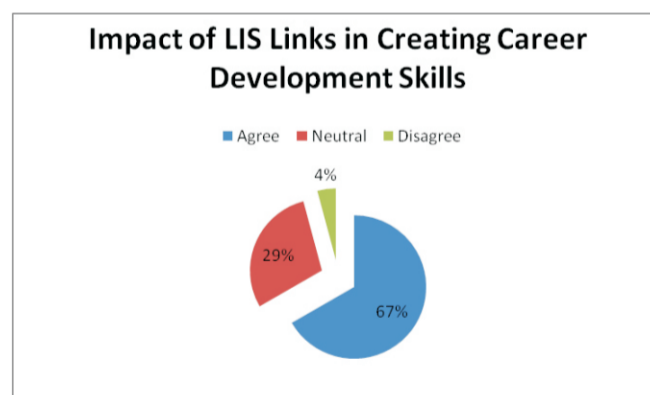

Most of LIS Professionals 31% were use LIS Links everyday. 31% LIS Professionals were use LIS Links in creating career development through latest news & events. 67% respondents were agreeing that LIS Links works as platform for career development skills. 58% respondents were satisfied with LIS Links. 52% respondents were face lack of time in the use of LIS Links.

12. Conclusion

The research is an attempt to identify and analyze the effect of ICT environment of India's first largest social network site library and information science links (LIS Links) in learning followed by the impact of understanding its role in career development skills of LIS Professionals. It has become one of the largest platforms in the India for sharing knowledge. The uniqueness of LIS Links is to share information among users.
