INTRODUCTION



Blogs offer a platform for learners to express themselves in a new language. Twitter functions as a microblogging site. Microblogging involves writing very short updates on what you are doing, your ideas, activities. Similarly we have other social networking sites like face-book through which learner can develop their writing skill in English language. It needs to create a class group on social networking site. If a group has a clearly defined purpose, which can be defined in class, this will encourage online activity. The teacher can act as an administrator, suggesting topics for discussion.

A creative teacher at junior college level is supposed to devise more innovative activities from the text-book. So the teacher must prepare a bank of various types activities like- If the teacher has formed a whats app group, he may set an activity as follows- Name and explain the figure of speech in the following line.

In this activity, maximum students may respond to this activity and finally the teacher will interact with the students telling them correct or wrong. Such kinds of activities in whats app, facebook, twitter, blog, etc. may remove fear and stress from the mind of the learners and definitely will increase the interest in the subject of English. Similarly, the teacher may assign an activity like enabling students to prepare sequence of jumbled sentences, creating true/false type activities, enabling the students to think and match the words and their meanings etc. with the help of these social networking services.

In this process of teaching and learning English language at junior college level, a lot of information about grammar of English language can be shared and informed quickly online with the help of these different applications. Of course, it saves time of both teacher and students to large extend. The only problem here is that, in developing countries, the older teachers are less familiar with varied functions and applications of these social networking services.
