The above table shows that all college libraries facing problem in implementing ICT. Few colleges' libraries are responses that their staffs are interactive and they are eager to learn ict but due to the negligence of higher authority they are not in position to learn the ict properly. Lack of finance is another obstruction to implement the ict in college libraries. Staffs are insufficient in almost all college libraries.

FINDINGS:

- I. the collection of non-book materials like DVD/CD etc. are very few in number and many of them even don't have non book materials
- II. ICT infrastructure are not so adequate
- III. Lack of human resources
- IV. Lack of acquisition policy
- V. Lack of e-resources, except 2 or 3 colleges most of them do not have any kind of e-resources
- VI. Staffs are not properly trained with ICT.
- VII. Inadequacy of finance in implementation of ict

CONCLUSION:

College library hold an important position in the academic institution. College library fulfil the objectives of college and help in teaching and research process. The librarian must be prepared to exploit resources by providing information and subject matter at the right time and a suitable level and help the teachers and students.
