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
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
"IMPACT OF PRIVATIZATION OF EDUCATION ON THE SOCIETY IN MAHABALESHWER"

Table: 2. reveals that the negative views of the respondents about the privatization of education in the study area. Out of the total respondents, 68 per cent expressed that Privatization of education always gives emphasis on profit. It charges different fees to increase its income. Moreover, government officials and educational authorities bribe to grant permission to the private educational institutions. It increases the cost of education and it is beyond the fixed capacity of poor and middle income groups. Mushroom growth of private educational institution demands qualified and experienced faculties to provide quality education and earn goodname in the public. But it appoints non- qualified and experienced persons based on caste, religion and region. So the quality of the most of the faculties is poor in language, subjects and character.

It is seen that most of respondents have the same opinion in the study area. The study found that infrastructure facilities in the self- financed college inadequate and poor. Maximum number of the ofthe schools do not have separate buildings, especially for staff and library. Privatization has turned education in to economic goods and it is bought and sold for money. So, privatization of education has become one of the profit making commercial goods in the market- economy. So, anybodycan establish educational institutions and run this business through agents and advertisements. Privatization has made education poor quality but a restless service.

It is observed that there is many problems such as poor quality of the infrastructure and lack of quality of education.

5. SUGGESTIONS

- 1. It is suggested that qualified and experienced staff should be appointed irrespective of casts and religion wise in the school.
- 2. It is suggests that any system that increasingly relies on private provision to fulfill the right to education, by reinforcing gender inequalities, creates a cycle wherein women and girls have diminishing access to quality education.
- **3.** There is privatization of education is ignoring quality improvement in the schools. It should be regulated to keep private institutions in checked and ensure quality control.

6. CONCLUSIONS

It has been concluded that the role of privatization is important to expend education in qualitatively and quantitatively in the Indian society. Therefore, state and the central governments encourage the privatization of education to achieve economic development through maximum utilization of human resources.
