HYPOTHESIS

1. There is no significant difference in teacher effectiveness between the teacher educators working in government and private institutions.

METHOD & SAMPLE

Survey method was used for this study. A stratified random sample of 300 teacher educators was selected from government and private institutions in Chennai district.

Table-1 depicts that the calculated t-value (0.41) is less than the table value at 0.05 level.
