# WHAT ARE VALUES?

According to Milton Rokeach: "A value is an enduring belief that a specific mode of conduct or end state of existence is personally or socially preferable to an opposite or converse mode of conduct or end state of existence." Without going into a debate about the definition of value, it is generally accepted that five universal human values i.e. Truth, Righteous conduct, Peace, Love and Non-violence are directly linked to physical, intellectual, emotional psyche and spiritual facets of human personality. These values are essentially acquired during childhood, first in the home and then at school. This is not a new issue. It has been discussed in different forms from time to time. The National Education Policy, 1986, spoke about creating awareness of India's common cultural heritage, social justice and compassion, democracy and egalitarianism, secularism, gender equlity, concern for environment, social cohesion and national unity, population and quality of life and scientific outlook and spirit of enquiry.

Unfortunately, very little action was taken to implement this important part of the education policy. The school atmosphere, the personality and behavior of teachers is a major factor in developing the sense of values. It must be emphasized that consciousness of values must permeate the whole curriculum and programme of activities in the school. With the availability of electronic media, it should be possible to develop audiovisual capsules based on clippings of films and TV materials showing virtues of honesty, integrity, compassion and selfless service. In addition, short film son real life examples from lives of great personalities like Mahatma Gandhi, Mother Teresa and Baba Amte will have much treater impact on young minds than sermons on morality. The programme for value inculcation can be further enriched by organizing visits to homes for destitute children and aged persons to develop values of compassion and kindness. These programmers should also include extension activities and community service by teachers and students to teach dignity of labour and selfless service.

# TEACHER'S ROLE IN INCULCATING MORAL VALUES IN STUDENTS?

We cannot also ask the child to lie when it is convenient for us – for example, "Tell them I am not a t home" when you want to avoid a phone call, give a subtle message to the child that it is OK to lie.

# **Praise Openly:**

There are many occasions when the child displays good behavior. Make her feel special whenever she does well. Let her realize that good behavior leads to instant acknowledgement and positive strokes. Tell everyone around, and within her hearing, of your joy and pride on her positive behavior. Create a self image in her mind that will encourage her to make values an integral part of her character. Giving a gift/ reward for positive behavior may not be sustainable nor is it the right thing to do.

# **Counsel Mildly:**

There sould be occasions when the child falters and it is the responsibility of every parent to counsel the child. The method of counseling would have tto be mild. It cannot be done by using force, threats or even punishment. The child should be made to realize through a soft discussion on the consequences of not practicing values. Old stories may be repeated and used for reinforcing. The whole effort would have to be to get the commitment from the child to be better in future. We should realize that no one is perfect and that everyone deserves a chance to improve and evolve.

# Make Rules:

It is easy to form habits when one is young and something is repeated frequently. There are many simple values that can be built in our children if we have simple rules in force. For example, we can have rules of etiquette to be followed religiously – Saying "please" "Thank you", talking softly and smiling often can all be programmed in children at an early age.

## Right environment:

For a child to inculcate values, it is important for her to grow up iin the right environment. Parents can help in this process significantly. Is she having the right kind of friends? Is she having the right kind of activities? Is the school right for this? Is she staying in the right locality? Is she watching the right kind of programs? All of these are factors which have direct/ indirect influences on her character. Choosy parents will make sure that every aspect is attended to and that there are no negative influences coming her way.

# **Shower Trust:**

One important dimension that parents should remember is to trust their child. They should explicitly and implicitly tell the child that they trust her fully. They should never be seen as probing too deeply and

checking every single thing minutely. This is especially true as the child reaches adolescence. Otherwise, it might cause the child to rebel and display opposite behavior.
