A COMPARATIVE STUDY OF VERBAL AGGRESSION OF INTER UNIVERSITY AND INTER COLLEGIATE MALE PLAYERS OF DR. BABASAHEB AMBEDKAR MARATHWADA UNIVERSITY

ABSTRACT

he purpose of this study was to compare the verbal aggression between inter university and inter collegiate team game male players of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University. The study was conducted on hundred samples, consisting of fifty Intercollegiate and fifty Inter-university team game male players of different colleges affiliated to Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University. Verbal Aggression was measured by administrating Buss- Durkee's Aggression Scale. The data collected through aforesaid tests were analyzed with respect to verbal aggression. T test was applied to compute the significances between inter university and inter collegiate male players. The significance of data was judged at .05 levels. The result of



the study indicates that verbal aggression of Inter-collegiate and inter university team game male players was same.

INTRODUCTION

Aggression as a spontaneous impulsive act of anger. Aggression is observable behavior which can depreciate, threaten or hurt a person or destroy an object. It is unplanned and usually occurs during times of stress. Aggression is viewed as a loss of self-control or an impulse break-through.

DELIMITATIONS:

The study has been delimited to the inter-college and inter university level team game male players. Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Basketball, Cricket and Hockey players, in the age group of 18-27 years were drawn from Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University Aurangabad and colleges affiliated to them.

OBJECTIVES OF THE STUDY:

The objectives of the study are stated as follows:

1)To study the verbal aggression of Inter University team game male players of Dr. Babasahab Ambedkar Marathwada University.

2)To study the verbal aggression of Inter collegiate team game male players of Dr. Babasahab Ambedkar Marathwada

University.

3)To compare the verbal aggression between Inter collegiate and Inter University team game male players.

HYPOTHESES:

- 1)There would be no significant difference between Inter university and inter collegiate team game male players on verbal aggression.
- 2)There would be significant difference between Inter university and inter collegiate team game male players on verbal aggression.

METHODOLOGY:

Selection of Sample:

The sample consists of hundred male players of Dr. Babasahab Ambedkar Marathwada University. The subjects were drawn from the colleges affiliated to Dr. Babasahab Ambedkar Marathwada University Aurangabad. Random Sampling Technique was employed to select the subjects. The data was collected from Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, Basketball, Cricket and Hockey team game male players. The researcher will use survey research methodology for the study.

Tools used:

Buss- Durkee's Aggression questionnaire has been taken to assess the verbal aggression. This questionnaire consisted of twenty nine statements.

Method for Analysis:

Student's T test has been applied to find out the significant differences among two groups at 0.05 level of significance. The collected data were tabulated to find out the difference of verbal aggression among intercollegiate and interuniversity team game male players.


