
#### **EMOTIONAL EXPRESSIONS:**



2.Lynn Westbrook, (2007) "Chat reference communication patterns and implications: applying politeness theory", Journal of Documentation, Vol. 63 Iss: 5, pp.638 – 658 is of the view that Syntactic formality markers include regular use of contractions, slang, sentence fragments, and non-standard punctuation as well as limited use of acronyms and abbreviations with rare use of emoticons. Content-based markers included apologies, self-disclosure, and expressions of extreme need. Use patterns are related to the level of responsibility assumed by the librarian as well as the interview stages.

3.Ohbyung Kwon, Choong-Ryuhn Kim, Gimun Kim, (2013) "Factors affecting the intensity of emotional expressions in mobile communications", Online Information Review, Vol. 37 Iss: 1, pp.114 – 131 reported that emotional intensity had a closer relationship to user acceptance than was expected. Second, the use of exclamation marks and emotional messages are far less acceptable in negative messages. Third, the high formalisation group has a more positive emotional intensity in their basic expression. The use of text-based communications such as instant messaging or social media such as Twitter has been growing significantly as the use of mobile devices increases. Not only do people share information via mobile communication, there are significant implications for advertising and marketing. Due to display limitations, however, the

message senders use various conventions in addition to the text-based message to more clearly and richly express emotions. Since users use a range of expressions to convey these emotions, it would be very useful to verify the relationships between users' emotional expressions and receivers' perceptions of the expressions.

4. Tshinakaho Relebogile Seaba, (Informatics Department, Tshwane University of Technology, Pretoria, South Africa), Raymond Mompoloki Kekwaletswe, (Faculty of ICT, Tshwane University of Technology, Pretoria, South Africa) argues that an e-collaboration environment, driven by awareness of social presence, may provide the just-in-time learning support needed by postgraduate students. The academic challenges faced by students may be alleviated if a correct electronic platform is provided for them to be able to consult with each other or their instructors, regardless of time or their locations. Thus, the paper conceptualises how awareness of social presence may help address the challenges by facilitating e-collaboration of postgraduate students.
