Principle of Graphology.

One of the core principles of the graphological approach is the belief that handwriting is a reflection of a person's personality. Graphologists believe that by examining a person's writing, they can gain insight into their character traits, emotional stability, cognitive abilities, and overall health.

Dr. Ludwig Klages, widely regarded as the father of modern graphology, publishes the influential handwriting and character. So technically, graphology is a study of functioning of our brain rather than of our handwriting. Our handwriting is essentially only a door to reach our brains. Technically, a right hander is so because the right side of his/her brain functions faster and better than the left side.

Theory of Handwriting:

Handwriting production is viewed as a constrained modulation of an underlying oscillatory process. Coupled oscillations in horizontal and vertical directions produce letter forms, and when superimposed on a rightward constant velocity horizontal sweep result in spatially separated letters. The science of handwriting analysis is based on the premise that no two individuals can produce exactly the same writing and that an individual cannot exactly produce his/her own handwriting due to writing variation. Variations are natural deviations that occur in a person's handwriting.

Graphology is a blend of art and science. It is a science because it measures the structure and movement of the written forms-slants, angles and spacing are accurately calculated and the pressure is observed in magnification and with precision.

Basics of Handwriting:

To study graphology, parts of letters have to be identified. When a writer makes a path in a single impulse, it is referred to as strokes. The strokes that go upwards forming letters are referred to as upward strokes, whereas the strokes that go downwards and comeback up forming letters are known as downward strokes.

- 1. Posture: Good sitting posture promotes good handwriting. This can be taught in Kindergarten and reinforced in every grade. When considering a child's posture, look at their desk. Does it fit their size? The right size and style of chair and desk affect school performance. Children don't come in a standard size. Check that every child can sit with their feet flat on the floor and arms resting comfortably. Children who sit on their feet often will lose stability in their upper torso.

- 3. Pencil grip: Grip is one of the foundations of handwriting. The most important thing to understand about pencil grip is that doesn't develop naturally- it is learned. - 4. Placement: Correct paper placement helps children to move the writing hand across the page. Paper placement is different for left and right-handed children. the forearm. Children who slant their papers properly can write faster because the arm moves naturally with the paper.Good sitting posture promotes good handwriting. Give your students paper that has double lines for correct letter orientation.

Rules include letters touch the bottom line, short letters start at middle dotted line, tall letters touch top line, spacing go between words, leave a finger space, and print letters the same.

It might take a bit longer than typing, but you'll help to build up the muscles that are necessary for easy, smooth, and neat handwriting. To practice your writing every day, start a journal, make your to-do lists by hand, or complete handwriting practice sheets.

Mimic The Handwriting You Admire.

Each day, choose one that you'd like to emulate. Then try to copy the look of that handwriting, letter by letter. Pay attention to how they connect letters, any decorative flourishes they use, and the shapes and angles they create. Spend around five minutes per day on this.

Characteristics of Hand writing:
